- \* Voyeurism (watching the child) or exhibitionism (exposing themselves)
- \* Taping or photographing the child in sexual positions or engaged in sexual acts
- \* Purposefully engaging in sexual acts in front of the child
- \* Exposing the child to pornography
- \* Any other situation where the child is used for the purpose of sexual stimulation without contact
